#### Autumn

#### Black History Month

We have been celebrating Black History Month during October. We have learned about the work of Black authors, poets and artists. We have enjoyed sharing stories and songs from different cultures. Our core book has been 'Baby Goes to Market' by Atinuke which inspired a visit to East Street Market where the children bought fruit and vegetables featured in the story. The children are working collaboratively to create a large-scale piece of art using the techniques of Frank Bowling. Parents have been very generous with their time and have been into Nursery to read to the children and teach them new songs. Other parents have talked to the children how they care for and style their children's hair. It has been a wonderful opportunity to learn from each other and celebrate our wonderful community.








#### Dates for your diary


Next week is the half-term break (24<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> October 2022).
