The children have enjoyed many books this term, including our Core Books. These have included:

'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' (trad)

The children enjoyed acting out this story in the garden, taking turns to be the troll and the goats. They also made bridges with wooden blocks inspired by photos of real bridges.







'Mr. Gumpy's Outing' by John Burningham

The children retold this story using props and puppets, with different voices for the animals in the boat. They made boats and other vehicles with loose parts in the garden. They enjoyed lots of water play and ice exploration and even made their own ice lollies.









'The Colour Monster Goes To School' by Anna Llenas

We have been sharing stories about going to school and transitions and how this makes us feel. The children will have lots of different feelings at the moment, and 'The Colour Monster Goes To School' and 'Ruby's Worry' encourage us to talk about how we feel.
