

Fortnight beginning 29/09/25

the light,


And five little pumpkins tumbled out of sight.



You can help your child by reading with your child every day, singing our core rhyme together, and reciting and acting out the poem.


Makaton

<u>Autumn</u>

As we look around us we are beginning to see signs of Autumn everywhere - falling leaves, conkers, acorns and the colours changing from green to red, yellow, orange and brown. Go for a walk in the park. What can you see? Maybe collect some leaves and seeds to make pictures and patterns.



Independence

Putting on our shoes and coats, learning to dress and undress, using the toilet and washing our hands, and using cutlery to eat are all skills that we need to learn. Keep practising these skills so that you can become more and more independent.
