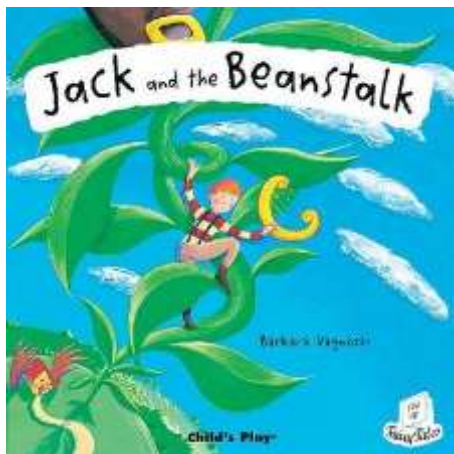


This fortnight our core book is 'Jack and the Beanstalk'

Makaton

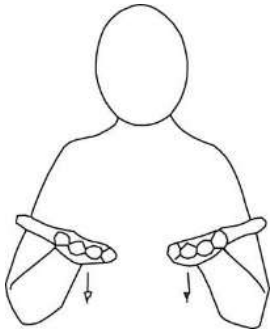

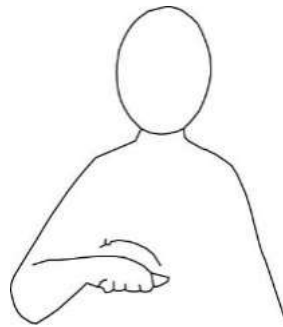
